LETTER DATED 7 JULY 1964 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF
CAMBODIA ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On the instructions of the Royal Government of Cambodia, I have the honour to transmit to you the following, for the information of the members of the Security Council:

"On 6 June 1964, a helicopter of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Viet-Nam flew at low altitude over the province of Mondalkiri.

On 10 June, two aircraft of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Viet-Nam flew over the post at Vath Veang Keo, in the province of Kandal.

On 19 June, at 9 a.m., a jet aircraft of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Viet-Nam flew over the village of Chipeh, in the khum of Mimot, in the province of Kompong Cham.

On 21 June, at 10.30 a.m., two single-engine aircraft of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Viet-Nam three times flew over the villages of Daun Rath and Chambak, in the khums of Rong and Da, in the srok of Mimot, in the province of Kompong Cham.

During the night of 21 June, four jet aircraft of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Viet-Nam twice flew over the khum of Som, in the srok of Kirivong, in the province of Takeo."

I should be grateful if you would arrange for the circulation of this letter as a document of the Security Council.
