LETTER DATED 21 JULY 1964 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
CAMBODIA ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On the instructions of the Royal Government of Cambodia, I have the honour to transmit the following to you, for the information of the members of the Security Council:

1. "On 11 June 1964, at 6.30 a.m., soldiers belonging to the armed forces of the Republic of Viet-Nam, from the post at Giang Thanh, Hatien, landed from two motor boats at the phum of Prey Prous in Khmer territory, in the khum of Prek Kroeus, srok of Kampong Trach, province of Kampot, in an attempt to kidnap some Khmer peasants. The aggressors withdrew after a five-minute exchange of fire with the Cambodian police."
2. "On 1 July 1964, at approximately 7 a.m., armed forces of the Republic of Viet-Nam from the posts at Khanh Binh, Dongcoki, Ca Coi and Nhom Hoi, which lie facing the srok of Koh Thom, province of Kandal, fired a number of shots towards Khmer territory. During the shooting a bullet struck and seriously wounded a fifty-year-old Cambodian woman who was 200 metres inside Khmer territory, in the khum of Sampeoun, srok of Koh Thom, province of Kandal."

I should be grateful if you would arrange for this letter to be circulated as a Security Council document.
