LETTER DATED 27 JULY 1964 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CAMBODIA ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL.

On the instructions of the Royal Government of Cambodia, I have the honour to communicate the following to you for the information of the members of the Security Council:

"On 12 July 1964, at 10.30 a.m., some fifty soldiers of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Viet-Nam penetrated 100 metres into Khmer territory in the Khum of Triek, Srok of Mimot, Province of Kompong Cham.

"Following a clash with police units, the aggressors with drew into South Viet-Nam." $\,$

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a Security Council document.
