

MESSAGE DATED 6 AUGUST 1964 FROM ARCHEISHOP MAKARIOS, PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF CYPRUS, ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I wish to refer to my communication transmitted to you by the Permanent Representative of Cyprus to the United Nations, on 28 July,* and further thereto to state that irrespective of the legal views expressed in that communication it is my desire to assure Your Excellency that the United Nations force in Cyprus will enjoy full freedom of movement throughout the territory of the Republic. The only exception will be certain localities connected with the defence of the State, access to which may be arranged after consultation between the Government and the Commander of UNPICYP, General Thimayya.
