LETTER DATED 5 MAY 1989 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF THE
PERMANENT MISSION OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED
NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government and pursuant to my letter dated 2 May 1989 (S/20615), I have the honour to inform you of further violations of the cease-fire by Iraqi forces. The numerical sequence of violations follows the sequence in the said letter.

1407. At 1000 hours on 14 April 1989, a loader was used in the process of road construction at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 19-83 on the map of Halaleh.

1408. At 1100 hours on 14 April 1989, 10 Iraqis at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 006-984 on the map of Salehabad and 6 Iraqis at the geographic co-ordinates of PB 861-044 on the map of Salehabad were digging canals.

1409. At 1100 hours on 14 April 1989, two IFA vehicles on three occasions transported ammunition from the geographic co-ordinates of NC 006-984 to NB 999-989, from NC 006-984 to NC 025-970 and from NC 006-986 to NB 999-989 on the map of Salehabad.

1410. From 1300 to 1640 hours on 14 April 1989, a new observation post was being built at the geographic co-ordinates of PB 784-145 on the map of Mehran.

1411. On 14 April 1989, Iraqi forces occupied Yalshushi and built a base therein at the geographic co-ordinates of PD 943-089 on the map of Nousud.

1412. On 14 April 1989, a new defensive barricade was built at the geographic co-ordinates of QA 980-072 on the map of Meimeh and Kuhtappeh.

1413. On 14 April 1989, offensive positions were built at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 484-567 on the map of Sumar.

1414. On 14 April 1989, an observation post was built in the vicinity of the geographic co-ordinates of NC 714-516 on map No. 13.

1415. On 14 April 1989, two firing positions previously built on 4 April 1989 at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 490-563 on the map of Sumar were interconnected by new canals with two other positions built on 6 April 1989 at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 490-562 on the same map.

1416. At 0900 and 0930 hours on 15 April 1989, some 20 to 30 Iraqis were building some four to five offensive barricades at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 525-536 and NC 513-558 on the map of Sumar.

1417. At 0950 hours on 15 April 1989, 15 Iraqis were building three rest barricades at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 491-562 on the map of Sumar.

1418. From 1240 to 1900 hours on 15 April 1989, a loader was in operation at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 412-598, NC 407-597 and NC 405-585 on the map of Sumar.

1419. At 1600 hours on 15 April 1989, an IFA vehicle was discharging reinforcement personnel at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 870-520 and NC 760-530 on map No. 13.

1420. From 1600 to 1830 hours on 15 April 1989, a loader was in the process of excavations at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 505-502 on the map of Sumar.

1421. At 0030, 0950 and 1055 hours on 16 April 1989, three IFA vehicles were seen discharging fresh forces at the geographic co-ordinates of PE 562-034 on the map of Mehran.

1422. At 0620 hours on 16 April 1989, 20 Iraqis were digging several firing barricades at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 513-558 on the map of Sumar.

1423. At 0700 hours on 16 April 1989, 40 Iraqis were digging canals and building rest barricades at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 603-494 on the map of Sumar and some others were digging canals at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 713-513 on map No. 13.

1424. From 0300 to 0840 hours on 16 April 1989, some 17 Iraqis were building new barricades and patrolling the area at the geographic co-ordinates of TQ 31-19 on the map of Hoseinieh.

1425. At 0830 hours on 16 April 1989, a shovel was used to dig a 15-metre canal at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 42-55 on the map of Sumar.

1426. At 1010 hours on 16 April 1989, a new base was being built at the geographic co-ordinates of NF 633-039 on the map of Piranshahr.

1427. At 1050 hours on 16 April 1989 14 Iraqis were digging canals at the geographic co-ordinates of NE 385-900 on the map of Panjwein.

1428. From 1230 to 1700 hours on 16 April 1989, 24 Iraqis were building new barricades at the geographic co-ordinates of QA 57-53 on the map of Yebeis and at the geographic co-ordinates of QA 73-44, QA 76-41 and QA 71-45 on the map of Einkhosh.

1429. At 1400 hours on 16 April 1989, 15 Iraqis were building new barricades at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 153-917 on the map of Halaleh. The Iraqis were also digging canals at several points between the geographic co-ordinates of NC 127-899 and NC 179-857 on the same map.

1430. On 16 April 1989 several canals were dug during the night at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 483-566, NC 487-566 and NC 486-566 on the map of Sumar.

1431. On 16 April 1989, two observation posts were built at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 707-512 and NC 687-502 on map No. 13.

1432. On 16 April 1989, the Iraqis, in addition to reinforcing all other existing bases in the area, built a new base at the geographic co-ordinates of NE 606-047 on the map of Piranshahr.

1433. On 16 April 1989, a 50-metre wall was built up at the geographic co-ordinates of NE 706-656 on the map of Baneh.

1434. On 16 April 1989, a new position was built at the geographic co-ordinates of NE 661-689 on the map of Baneh.

1435. On 16 April 1989, old canals were repaired and new barricades were built at the geographic co-ordinates of NE 377-905 on the map of Panjwein. A new observation post was also built at the geographic co-ordinates of NE 407-914 and NE 396-885 on the same map.

1436. At 0800 hours on 17 April 1989, two new observation positions were built at the geographic co-ordinates of PB 794-144 and PB 795-146 on the map of Salehabad.

1437. At 0900 hours on 17 April 1989, a loader was in operation at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 412-595 on the map of Sumar.

1438. From 0930 to 2100 hours on 17 April 1989, Iraqis were digging canals at the geographic co-ordinates of TQ 31-18 on the map of Hoseinieh.

1439. From 1020 to 1800 hours on 17 April 1989, a shovel was used to dig a 200-metre canal at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 508-505 on the map of Sumar.

1440. At 1055 hours on 17 April 1989, 15 Iraqis were digging canals at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 144-888 on the map of Halaleh.

1441. At 1055 hours on 17 April 1989, 15 Iraqis were digging canals at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 146-888 on the map of Halaleh.

1442. At 1100 hours on 17 April 1989, six Iraqis were building new observation barricades at the geographic co-ordinates of ND 216-698 on the map of Ghal'eh.
1443. At 1100 hours on 17 April 1989, 14 Iraqis were building new barricades at the geographic co-ordinates of QA 76-44 on the map of Einkhosh.
1444. At 1120 hours on 17 April 1989, four Iraqis were building a new firing barricade at the geographic co-ordinates of NC 477-573 on the map of Sumar.
1445. At 1525 hours on 17 April 1989, four Iraqis were building a new firing barricade at the geographic co-ordinates of ND 217-687 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin.
1446. On 17 April 1989, interconnecting canals were dug between the geographic co-ordinates of NC 180-858 and NC 126-879 on the map of Halaleh.
1447. On 17 April 1989, new canals were dug between the geographic co-ordinates of ND 693-819 and ND 697-817 on the map of Ozgoleh and an observation post was built at the geographic co-ordinates of ND 702-812 on the same map.
1448. At 1050 hours on 18 April 1989, some Iraqis were demolishing six rest barricades at the geographic co-ordinates of NE 3915-9010 on the map of Panjwein and some others were building new observation barricades at the geographic co-ordinates of NE 394-903 on the same map.
1449. On 19 April 1989, Iraqi forces captured a new position at the geographic co-ordinates of NF 624-038 on the map of Piranshahr.
1450. On 19 April 1989, a sand-bag observation post was built at the geographic co-ordinates of NE 659-930 on the map of Tanur.
1451. On 19 April 1989, two new barricades were built at the geographic co-ordinates of NE 837-302 and NE 847-302 on the map of Kak.
1452. On 19 April 1989, a new position was built at the geographic co-ordinates of NF 606-047 on the map of Piranshahr.
1453. On 19 April 1989, Iraqi forces occupied an old Iranian position in the neutral zone at the geographic co-ordinates of NF 633-032 on the map of Piranshahr.
