LETTER DATED 7 AUGUST 1964 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF CAMBODIA
ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On the instructions of the Royal Government of Cambodia, I have the honour to communicate the following to you for the information of the members of the Security Council:

"On 3 August 1964, at approximately 8.15 a.m., two jet aircraft of the Armed Forces of the Republic of Viet-Nam flew at a low altitude over Phum Khley, khum of Treak, srok of Mimot, province of Kompong Cham, at approximately three kilometres inside Khmer territory.

After firing bursts from machine-guns on the said Phum Khley, the two aircraft withdrew to South Viet-Nam."

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a Security Council document.
