LETTER DATED 8 AUGUST 1964 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF TURKEY  
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Water supply for the Turkish quarter of Ktima town has been cut off by the Greeks as from the morning of 5 August. In this way about 2,500 Turks including old people, women and children are being condemned to death in the most brutal and uncivilized manner.

Bringing to Your Excellency's knowledge this disgraceful and inhuman action of Greeks, which will no doubt be condemned by the entire civilized world, I appeal urgently for effective measures to be taken by Your Excellency and by the Security Council.
