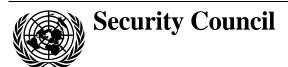

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Regional Cooperation and NEPAD of the Republic of Ghana presents its compliments to the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1737 (2006), and has the honour to report, pursuant to the relevant provisions of resolution 1737 (2006), that the relations of the Republic of Ghana with the Islamic Republic of Iran are not in conflict with the provisions of Security Council resolution 1737 (2006).

In furtherance of the applicable provisions of resolution 1737 (2006), the Government of Ghana is circulating a directive to all relevant central institutions of State in order to ensure the strict application of the provisions of the resolution, in accordance with relevant laws, regulations and administrative procedures.

Furthermore, the Government of the Republic of Ghana has put in place a national coordination mechanism, composed of relevant national institutions, responsible for ensuring compliance with the provisions of all Security Council resolutions, including Security Council resolution 1737 (2006).
