CABLE DATED 22 JUNE 1965 FROM THE ASSISTANT SECRETARY GENERAL  
OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES ADDRESSED TO THE  
SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE UNITED NATIONS

In accordance with Article 54 Charter United Nations I have the honour to transmit to you for information Security Council the following text of cable No. 188 sent by Dr. José A. Mora, Secretary General of this organization, to the Chairman of the Tenth Meeting of Consultation:

"Santo Domingo, 21 June 1965

"Message No. 188

"Today we continued interviews with Dominican personalities strengthening our conviction existence of generally favourable opinion proposal made to the parties. With regard to the work of the Inter-American Commission on Human Rights, Professor Carlos Alberto Dunshee de Abranches arrived to carry on the work begun by the Chairman, Manuel Bianchi. In the morning that Commission visited the State Counsel General of the Republic to arrange for persons detained in La Victoria prison to be visited by their families; secured permission for visits to take place every Tuesday and Friday. In the afternoon Commission visited Commanding Officer Inter-American Peace Force who reaffirmed intention to co-operate in protection human rights. Commission also visited Sans Souci prison where it found good conditions for those detained especially as regards food and hygiene. Prisoners under sentence here are allowed visits on Tuesdays, Fridays and Sundays and persons detained may receive and send correspondence.
