LETTER DATED 2 JUNE 1965 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF GREECE ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Following my letter No. P3365-80 of 1 June 1965, I have the honour to inform Your Excellency that my Government has lodged a formal protest with the Turkish Government about another violation of Greek air space which took place on 31 May 1965, this being the fifth violation of that day.

At 2045 hours, two Turkish military jet aircraft flew over Cape Maleas of the island of Iesbos $(59^{\circ}02^{\circ}$ north - $26^{\circ}55^{\circ}$ east) at an altitude of 5,000 feet.

I would appreciate it if Your Excellency would have this letter reproduced as a document of the Security Council.
