NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

At the 39th plenary meeting of its thirty-eighth session, on 28 October 1983, the General Assembly adopted resolution 38/5, entitled "Co-operation between the United Nations and the Organization of African Unity". ^{1/} In paragraph 24 of that resolution, the General Assembly

"Calls upon United Nations bodies - in particular the Security Council, the Economic and Social Council, the Special Committee on the Situation with regard to the Implementation of the Declaration on the Granting of Independence to Colonial Countries and Peoples, the Special Committee against Apartheid and the United Nations Council for Namibia - to continue to associate closely the Organization of African Unity with all their work concerning Africa".
