Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 56th meeting, on 6 December 1983, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/38/62) on the administrative and financial implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Sixth Committee (A/38/66, para. 10). The report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/38/SR.56).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, by 50 votes to 14, with 14 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the Sixth Committee (A/38/661, para. 10), an additional appropriation of \$59,100 would be required under section 26 of the proposed programme budget for the biennium 1984-1985.
