Administrative and financial implications of draft resolutions V and III recommended by the Third Committee (A/38/681, para. 21)

Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 65th meeting, on 14 December 1983, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statements by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/38/77) and A/C.5/38/80) on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolutions V and III recommended by the Third Committee (A/38/681, para. 21), and the related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/38/7/Add.19).
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/38/SR.65).

DECISIONS OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

- A. Preparations for the World Conference to Review and Appraise the Achievements of the United Nations Decade for Women
- 3. With regard to draft resolution V recommended by the Third Committee (A/38/681, para. 21), the Committee decided, by 81 votes to 2, with 14 abstentions, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution, additional appropriations totalling \$1,040,600 would be required under the programme budget for the biennium 1984-1985 apportioned as follows:

An additional appropriation of \$93,400 would also be required under section 31 (Staff assessment), which would be offset by an increase of the same magnitude in the estimates of income under income section 1 (Income from staff assessment). Conference-servicing requirements would arise which are estimated on a full-cost basis at \$889,400. The actual additional appropriations that might be required in that respect would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of conference-servicing requirements to be submitted at a later stage during the current session.

B. Voluntary Fund for the United Nations Decade for Women

4. With regard to draft resolution III recommended by the Third Committee (A/38/681, para. 21), the Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution, no additional appropriation would be required at this stage.
