ANNEX

Press communiqué dated 5 May 1989 of the
Council of Ministers of the Coalition
Government of Democratic Kampuchea

1. On 5 May 1989, in Bangkok, the CGDK's Council of Ministers held its extraordinary meeting under the High Chairmanship of H.R.H. Samdech NORODOM SIHANOUK, Leader of the Cambodian National Resistance and President of Democratic Kampuchea.

H.E. Mr. SON Sann, Prime Minister of the CGDK, H.E. Mr. KHIEU Samphan, Vice-President of Democratic Kampuchea in charge of Foreign Affairs, and H.R.H. Prince NORODOM Ranariddh, Personal Representative of H.R.H. Samdech NORODOM SIHANOUK in Cambodia and Asia, as well as a number of other Ministers of the CGDK attended the meeting.

2. The Council of Ministers reviewed, as one of the main agenda items, the efforts in the search for a political settlement of the conflict in Cambodia. In this respect, the Council of Ministers would like to express its support to the proposal of H.R.H. Samdech NORODOM SIHANOUK that a round-table meeting of the four Cambodian parties under the Chairmanship of Samdech, and an International Conference on Cambodia be held in Paris, France, later this year, in order to seek a comprehensive political solution to the conflict in Cambodia on the basis of the 5-point peace plan of H.R.H. Samdech NORODOM SIHANOUK.

3. The Council of Ministers would like to reiterate that a just and durable political solution to the conflict in Cambodia should secure:

- (i) The withdrawal of all the Vietnamese occupying forces from Cambodia under effective international verification and control.
- (ii) The formation of a provisional quadripartite government under the leadership of H.R.H. Samdech NORODOM SIHANOUK, which will organize free and general elections in Cambodia under strict international supervision.
- (iii) The deployment of an International Peace Keeping Force in Cambodia.

4. The Council of Ministers would like to take this opportunity to express its deep gratitude to all peace-, justice- and freedom-loving countries the world over for their invaluable support to the Cambodian people's struggle to regain their national independence, and to call on them to continue to do the same until Cambodia is free and one hundred per cent independent and sovereign within her territorial integrity.
