LETTER DATED 20 MARCH 1963 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF PARAGUAY ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

One paragraph of the letter from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Cuba to the Secretary-General of the United Nations, which was circulated on 13 March 1963 in Security Council document S/5259, contains insulting references to the Head of State of Paraguay and describes as false his accusation regarding subversive movements in Paraguay, inspired by Cuban agents.

On behalf of my Government, I categorically deny the slanderous allegation made in the paragraph which is the subject of this letter. The subversive activities inspired by Cuba have been fully substantiated; and they certainly do not differ from other similar activities, also inspired by Cuba, in other Latin American countries.

I should be glad if you would arrange for this letter to be circulated as a Security Council document.
