LETTER DATED 8 JUNE 1963 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF THE UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS ADDRESSED TO THE
PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

On instructions from the Government of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, I have the honour to request you to convene the Security Council in order to consider the reports of the Secretary-General to the Council on developments relating to Yemen (documents S/5298 of 29 April, S/5321 of 27 May, S/5323 of 3 June and S/5325 of 7 June 1963), since the reports contain proposals concerning possible measures by the United Nations to maintain international peace and security, on which, under the Charter, decisions are taken by the Security Council.

I request you to arrange for the distribution of this letter as an official document of the Security Council.
