NOTE VERBALE DATED 7 JUNE 1963 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL, CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF GENERAL HAMILTON H. HOWZE AS COMMANDING GENERAL OF THE MILITARY FORCES MADE AVAILABLE TO THE UNIFIED COMMAND IN PURSUANCE OF THE RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY THE SECURITY COUNCIL ON 7 JULY 1950 (S/1588)

The Permanent Representative of the United States to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, acting under instructions from his Government, has the honour to inform the Security Council that the President of the United States has appointed General Hamilton H. Howze to replace General Guy S. Meloy, Jr., as the Commanding General of the Military Forces which Members of the United Nations have made available to the Unified Command under the United States, pursuant to the Security Council resolution of 7 July 1950 (S/1588).

The effective date of the change of command is 1 August 1963.

It is requested that this notification be communicated to the Security Council.
