LETTER DATED 16 AUGUST 1963 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE UNITED NATIONS

SITUATION BETWEEN THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC AND HAITI

RESOLUTION ON THE PRELIMINARY REPORT SUBMITTED BY THE COMMITTEE APPCINTED PY RESOLUTION OF APRIL 28, 1963, AND THE DECISION TO TRAVEL IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE MANDATE OF THE ORGAN OF CONSULTATION

(Adopted by the Council of the Organization of American States acting provisionally as Organ of Consultation at the meeting held on August 15, 1963)

THE COUNCIL OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES ACTING PROVISIONALLY AS ORGAN OF CONSULTATION,

HAVING SEEN the Preliminary Report submitted by the Committee appointed by resolution of April 23, 1963, which had been instructed to study the events denounced by the Government of Haiti on August 6, 1963; and

CONSIDERING:

That the aforesaid Committee has stated that it will travel to the region in order to continue its study,

RESOLVES:

To take note of the Preliminary Report presented by the aforesaid Committee and of its decision to travel to the region in order to continue its study in compliance with the mandate of this Organ, to which in the Resolutions of April 28, May 8, and August 6, 1963, refer.
