Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

During the week ending 29 December 2007, the Security Council took action on the following item:

Threats to international peace and security caused by terrorist acts (*see*

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5816th meeting, held on 27 December 2007 in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Pakistan, at his request, to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote.

The President stated that, following consultations of the Council, he had been authorized to make a statement on behalf of the Council and read out the text of that statement (for the text, see S/PRST/2007/50; to be issued in *Official Records of the Security Council, Resolutions and Decisions of the Security Council, 1 August 2007-31 July 2008*).
