REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CRIDENTIALS OF THE ALTERNATE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNITED KINGDOM ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 18 September 1952 from the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs of the United Kingdom appointing Mr. P.
