UNITED NATIONS COMMAND COMMUNIQUE NO. 1,459,
ISSUED IN TOKYO 10:00 A.M., WEDNESDAY,
DECEMBER 10, 1952 (KOREAN TIME)

United Nations Command raiding parties operated in the west sector of the Korean battlefield yesterday. Six enemy probes were repulsed in the west-central sector. An enemy probing attack of platoon strength was thrown back after a forty-minute engagement in the central area and an enemy probing patrol was unsuccessful in penetrating our lines in the east-central sector.

Carrier-based planes of the United Nations Command Fleet launched heavy attacks on enemy rail and supply centers Tuesday and surface craft blasted important enemy east coast targets.

Land-based aircraft hit enemy supply and communications targets, knocked an enemy plane out of the sky and blasted hostile front-line troops at the battle line. Cargo transports rounded out another period of transporting troops and materiel in support of United Nations Command forces in Korea.
