Note verbale dated 5 February 2008 from the Permanent Mission of Chad to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

On instructions from its Government, the Permanent Mission of the Republic of Chad presents its compliments to the President of the Security Council and wishes to draw the Council members' attention to the following message from the Chadian Government:

“There is a real risk that the situation in Chad will be further aggravated by new armed attacks from the Sudan aimed at overthrowing democratically established institutions, in flagrant violation of international law and of the statement adopted and issued by the Council on 4 February 2008 (S/PRST/2008/3). It is unacceptable for the Sudan to continue to flout the sacrosanct principles contained in the Charter of the African Union and the Charter of the United Nations, going so far as to defy these organizations once again by refusing to abide by their resolutions and decisions.

“These new armed attacks began two days ago in the localities of Adé and Adré, from the direction of the Sudanese border, and threaten to compromise all efforts to find a solution to the aggression being perpetrated against Chad. It is therefore extremely urgent for the Security Council to take up this matter once again, with a view to putting an immediate end to this aggression.”

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Chad to the United Nations requests that this note be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
