REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY  
COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE OF  
DENMARK ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to Rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 18 November 1952 from the Prime Minister of Denmark stating that Mr. William Borberg, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary, has been appointed Representative of Denmark on the Security Council.
