II. ANNOTATIONS TO THE PROVISIONAL AGENDA

Item 1. Adoption of the agenda

The Committee will be invited to adopt the agenda as set out in the present document, also taking into account any points raised for consideration by representatives of non-governmental organizations present at the meeting as observers.

Item 2. Relevant developments since the previous meeting of the Committee

The Committee will be invited to share any information on relevant developments since its previous meeting that is not covered under other agenda items.

The Committee will be invited to discuss any matters arising from its previous meetings.

Item 4. Submissions by Parties concerning other Parties

The Committee is expected to consider, in accordance with the relevant procedures, any submissions made by Parties concerning another Party's compliance with its obligations under the Convention, as provided for under paragraph 15 of the annex to decision I/7 of the Meeting of the Parties.

Item 5. Submissions by Parties concerning their own compliance

The Committee is expected to consider, in accordance with the relevant procedures, any submissions made by Parties concerning their own compliance with the obligations under the Convention, as provided for under paragraph 16 of the annex to decision I/7.

Item 6. Referrals by the secretariat

The Committee is expected to consider, in accordance with the relevant procedures, any referrals made by the secretariat concerning possible non-compliance by individual Parties with their obligations under the Convention, as provided for under paragraph 17 of the annex to decision I/7.

Item 7. Communications from members of the public

The Committee is mandated to consider, in accordance with the relevant procedures, communications from the public, as provided for under chapter VI of the annex to decision I/7.

- (a) The Committee is expected to finalize and adopt its findings and, if appropriate, recommendations with respect to communications ACCC/C/2005/15 (Romania), ACCC/C/2006/16 (Lithuania), ACCC/C/2006/17 (European Community) and ACCC/C/2006/18 (Denmark);
- (b) The Committee is expected to consider any new information received with regard to communications ACCC/C/2007/20 (Kazakhstan) and ACCC/C/2007/21 (European Community);
- (c) The Committee will discuss any new communications received sufficiently in advance of the meeting, in particular with respect to their admissibility and any issues that may need to be raised with the Party concerned;
 - (d) The Committee may discuss any other issues related to communications.

Item 8. Follow-up on specific cases of non-compliance

- (a) The Committee will be invited to discuss any progress with regard to implementation of decisions II/5, II/5a, II/5b and II/5c of the Meeting of the Parties (ECE/MP.PP/2005/2/Adds. 6–9);
- (b) The Committee is expected to review any information received in connection with the implementation of recommendations adopted following consideration of communications since the second meeting of the Parties, notably ACCC/C/2004/08 (Armenia) and ACCC/C/2005/12 (Albania).

Item 9. Review of compliance with reporting requirements and substantive matters arising from national implementation reports

The Committee is expected to monitor and assess, to the extent possible, the implementation of and compliance with the reporting requirements in accordance with its mandate (decision I/7, annex, para. 13 (c)). The results of this review will be included in the Committee's report to the Meeting of the Parties. The Committee is also expected to review the content of the available national implementation reports prepared for the third meeting of the Parties with a view to identifying aspects or trends that are relevant to compliance issues and, where appropriate, addressing these in its report to the Meeting of the Parties.
