CREDENTIALS OF REPRESENTATIVES

Report of the Credentials Committee

1. At its first plenary meeting, on 10 September 1979, the Conference, in accordance with paragraph 1 of rule 4 of its Rules of Procedure, appointed a Credentials Committee consisting of the following five members:

Ecuador	Syrian Arab Republic
Morocco	United States of America
Poland	

2. During the first session of the Conference the Credentials Committee met on 27 September 1979 and elected Major Mohamed Arrassen (Morocco) Chairman.

3. The Committee noted, on the basis of a report by the Executive Secretary, that the credentials of a considerable number of the 81 States participating in the Conference have not yet been received in proper order in conformity with rule 3 of the Rules of Procedure of the Conference. The Committee recommends that all delegations take appropriate measures to ensure that their credentials are in order by the beginning of the next session of the Conference.

4. The Committee decided, in view of the limited time available at this session of the Conference, not to proceed at this time with the verification of the credentials submitted to date.
