LETTER FROM THOR THORS, MINISTER OF ICELAND IN WASHINGTON, D.C.,  
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL DATED 2 AUGUST 1946

Excellency:

Acting under instructions from my Government I have the honor to inform Your Excellency that the Icelandic Parliament on July 25, 1946, passed a Resolution authorizing the Icelandic Government to apply for membership for Iceland in the United Nations.

In accordance with this Resolution and by authorization of my Government, I hereby have the honor to apply for membership for the Republic of Iceland in the United Nations and at the same time declare the willingness of Iceland to assume the obligations contained in the Charter of the United Nations.

Accept, Excellency, the assurances of my highest consideration.
