REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE
REPRESENTATIVE AND ALTERNATE REPRESENTATIVE OF CANADA
ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 27 December 1957 from the Permanent Representative of Canada to the United Nations, stating that the Government of Canada has designated Dr. R.A. MacKay as representative of Canada on the Security Council, and Mr. G.S. Murray as alternate representative of Canada on the Security Council.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this communication constitutes adequate provisional credentials.
