Guinea-Bissau configuration**

I have the honour to refer to the decision taken by the Organizational Committee of the Peacebuilding Commission on 17 December 2007 to establish the Commission's Guinea-Bissau configuration initially consisting of the members of the Organizational Committee. Subsequently and in accordance with paragraph 7 of General Assembly resolution 60/180 and Security Council resolution 1645 (2005), additional members of the Guinea-Bissau configuration were identified based on expression of interest and in consultation with the Chairperson of the configuration and the Permanent Representative of Guinea-Bissau.

The Organizational Committee considered the matter and decided to invite the Member States, organizations and entities listed in the annex to the present letter, and corresponding to the relevant subcategories of membership indicated under paragraph 7 of the above-mentioned resolutions, to become members of the Peacebuilding Commission's Guinea-Bissau configuration and to attend all of its future meetings.

I am pleased that we will be working collectively and closely together to address the peacebuilding needs of Guinea-Bissau, and I look forward to your most valuable contribution to the deliberations of, and activities undertaken by, the Peacebuilding Commission for that country.
