LETTER DATED 6 DECEMBER 1960 ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT
OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL BY THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF GUINEA

I have the honour to inform you that the Chairman of the delegation of the Republic of Guinea to the fifteenth session of the United Nations General Assembly has just been authorized by my Government to speak at the meetings of the Security Council convened today to consider once more the situation in the Congo.

I should therefore be very grateful if, in accordance with rule 37 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure, you would invite the Chairman of the delegation of the Republic of Guinea to take a place at the Council table and to speak when he deems it necessary.
