SUMMARY

Summary: The purpose of the present document is to improve the consistency of

the provisions concerning pressure receptacles.

Action to be taken: In paragraph 1.2.1, "Definitions", amend the definition of "gas

cartridge".

Introduction

1. In paragraph 1.2.1, "Definitions", the following definition of "gas cartridge" is provided: "any non-refillable receptacle containing, under pressure, a gas or a mixture of gases. It may be fitted with a valve". This definition is incorrect because not all non-refillable pressure receptacles are gas cartridges. We therefore propose that it be amended as follows.

Proposal

- 6. Amend, in paragraph 1.2.1, "Definitions", the definition of "gas cartridge" as follows:
 - ""Gas cartridge' means any a non-refillable receptacle containing, under pressure, a gas or a mixture of gases. It may be fitted with a valve."

Justification

- 3. <u>Safety</u>: the aim is to clarify the wording; consequently, there is no safety issue.
- 4. <u>Feasibility</u>: the aim is to clarify the wording; consequently, there is no feasibility issue.
- 5. <u>Enforceability</u>: the aim is to clarify the wording; consequently, there is no enforceability issue.
