- 1. At its 62nd meeting, on 13 December 1983, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/38/84) on the administrative and financial implications of the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee (A/38/637, para. 8). The report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions thereon was presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/38/SR.62).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution recommended by the First Committee (A/38/637, para. 8), conference-servicing requirements would arise, which are estimated, on a full-cost basis, at \$1,597,600. The actual additional appropriations that might be required in that respect would be considered in the context of the consolidated statement of conference-servicing requirements to be submitted at a later stage during the current session.
