#### Status of documentation

### Note by the Secretariat

- 1. In accordance with paragraph 8 of the annex to Economic and Social Council resolution 2008 (LX), the forty-eighth session of the Committee for Programme and Coordination will be held at Headquarters from 9 June to 3 July 2008.
- 2. In its resolution 1988/77 on its revitalization, the Council reiterated that the Secretariat should circulate relevant documentation in all working languages six weeks before the opening of sessions of the Council and its subsidiary organs.
- 3. In section III of its resolution 59/265, the General Assembly noted with deep concern that the six-week rule for the issuance of documents was not fully complied with owing to, inter alia, the continued late submission of documents by author departments. It requested the Secretary-General to ensure strict compliance with the six-week rule for issuance of documentation. In section III of its resolution 60/236 B, noting the continued high level of late submissions of documentation, the Assembly requested the Secretary-General to report to it at its sixty-first session, through the Committee on Conferences, on impediments, if any, to achieving full compliance with the 10-week and 6-week rules for the issuance of pre-session documents, including, where appropriate, proposed measures to address such impediments. It also requested the Secretary-General to develop a clear accountability mechanism within the Secretariat for the submission, processing and issuance of documentation and to present a detailed report to the Committee on Conferences for its further consideration and analysis, in order to provide concrete recommendations to the General Assembly at its sixty-first session.
- 4. In its resolutions 53/208 B on the pattern of conferences and subsequent resolutions and decisions thereon, the latest of which was resolution 62/225, the General Assembly: (a) reiterated its request to the Secretary-General to ensure that

documents were available in accordance with the six-week rule for their distribution simultaneously in the six official languages; (b) reaffirmed its decision that, if a report was issued late, the reason for the delay should be indicated when the report was introduced; and (c) decided that, if a report was submitted late to conference services, the reasons for the delay should be included in a footnote to the document.

- 5. In section IV of its resolution 62/225, the General Assembly reiterated its request to the Secretary-General to direct all departments to include, where appropriate, the following elements in their reports:
  - (a) A summary of the report;
  - (b) Consolidated conclusions, recommendations and other proposed actions;
  - (c) Relevant background information.
- 6. In those resolutions, the General Assembly reiterated its request that all documents submitted to legislative organs by the Secretariat and expert bodies for consideration and action have conclusions and recommendations marked in bold print.
