The Secretary-General has the honour to submit to the General Assembly and to the Security Council the following communication, dated 10 November 1965, which he has received from Mr. Abdullah El-Erian:

"Sir,

"I have the honour to refer to document A/6067-S/6817, which contains the list of candidates nominated by national groups for the election of a member of the International Court of Justice to fill the vacancy caused by the death of Judge Abdel Hamid Fadawi. While I am deeply sensible of the honour paid me, and am most grateful to the national group which has put forward my name, I must respectfully request you to be kind enough to inform the General Assembly and the Security Council that I do not wish to be considered as a candidate at this time.
