Letter dated 4 April 2008 from the Permanent Representative of Ghana to the United Nations addressed to the President of the General Assembly

I have the honour to inform you that in response to the request conveyed in your letter of 18 March 2008, I convened an informal meeting on 26 March 2008 of representatives of Permanent Missions of the top 10 providers of military personnel and civilian police to discuss the selection of five members to serve on the Organizational Committee of the Peacebuilding Commission, for a two-year term starting from 23 June 2008, pursuant to paragraph 4 (d) of General Assembly resolution 60/180.

Following the aforementioned meeting, and on the basis of informal consultations, the top 10 contributing countries have reached a consensus to select the five Member States listed below to serve on the Organizational Committee of the Peacebuilding Commission, for a two-year term starting from 23 June 2008:

Bangladesh India Pakistan Nepal Nigeria

While apprising you of the outcome of the facilitating role you entrusted to me, may I take this opportunity to express my appreciation to you for the confidence reposed in me, as well as to the other distinguished representatives of the group of top 10 providers for their kind cooperation.
