REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE ALTERNATE REPRESENTATIVES OF ZIMBABWE ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a letter dated 16 March 1984 from the Permanent Representative of Zimbabwe to the United Nations stating that Mr. James Manzou, Mr. Joey M. Bimha and Mr. Musafare C. Nyamudahondo have been appointed alternate representatives of Zimbabwe on the Security Council.
