NOTE DATED 22 APRIL 1959 FROM THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF GENERAL CARTER B. MAGRUDER AS COMMANDING GENERAL OF THE MILITARY FORCES MADE AVAILABLE TO THE UNIFIED COMMAND PURSUANT TO THE SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION OF 7 JULY 1950 (S/1588)

The Representative of the United States of America to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, acting under instructions from his Government, has the honour to inform the Security Council that the President of the United States has appointed General Carter B. Magruder to replace General George H. Decker as the Commanding General of the military forces which Members of the United Nations have made available to the Unified Command under the United States pursuant to the Security Council Resolution of 7 July 1950 (S/1588). The effective date of the change of command is 1 July 1959.

It is requested that this notification be communicated to the Security Council.
