Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration

Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, and in accordance with paragraph 7 of the note by the President dated 19 December 2007 (S/2007/749), the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The complete list of items of which the Security Council was seized as at 5 April 2008 is contained in document S/2008/10/Add.13 of 9 April 2008.

The present addendum lists the items on which the Security Council took action during the week ending 12 April 2008. The dates given for each item indicate when the item was first taken up by the Council at a formal meeting, and the most recent formal meeting of the Council held on that item.

The question concerning Haiti (16 June 1993; 8 April 2008)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5862nd meeting, held on 8 April 2008. The Council, under rule 37 of its provisional rules of procedure, invited the representative of Haiti, at his request, to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote. Under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure, the Council extended an invitation to Hédi Annabi, Special Representative of the Secretary-General and Head of the United Nations Stabilization Mission in Haiti.

The situation in the Middle East (18 July 1960; 8 April 2008)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5863rd meeting, held on 8 April 2008. The Council, under rule 37 of its provisional rules of procedure, invited the representative of Lebanon, at his request, to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote. Under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure, the Council extended an invitation to Daniel Bellemare, Commissioner of the International Independent Investigation Commission.
