Further to my letter dated 4 May 1989 (A/44/267-S/20618), I have the honour to inform you that, on 22 May 1989, a Scud missile was fired by Kabul troops from within Afghanistan and fell near Bhakkar.

The Afghan Chargé d'affaires was summoned to the Foreign Office in the afternoon of 7 June 1989 and a strong protest was lodged with him over this

incident. He was asked to inform his authorities that if such attacks did not cease the entire responsibility for the serious consequences would rest on the Kabul authorities.
