REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL
CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE REPRESENTATIVE OF TUNISIA TO THE
SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rules 14 and 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a cablegram dated 30 May 1958 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Tunisia, stating that Ambassador Mongi Slim and Secretary of State Ahmed Mestiri have been appointed to represent Tunisia at the Security Council.
