

COMMISSION ON HUMAN RIGHTS Thirty-fifth session 12 February-16 March 1979

#### PROVISIONAL AGENDA

## Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. The thirty-fifth session of the Commission on Human Rights will be held at the United Nations Office at Geneva from 12 February to 16 March 1979. The first meeting of the thirty-fifth session will be convened at 11 a.m. on Monday 12 February 1979.
- 2. The provisional agenda for the thirty-fifth session of the Commission drawn up in accordance with rule 5 of the Rules of Procedure of the Functional Commissions of the Economic and Social Council is attached. Annotations to the items listed in the provisional agenda will be issued in an addendum to the present document.
- 3. In connexion with items 10 (a) and 11 (a) it may be mentioned that in conformity with Commission decision 8 (XXXIV) and with the approval of the Economic and Social Council a working group open to all members of the Commission is scheduled to meet for one week immediately before the thirty-fifth session of the Commission, from 5 to 9 February 1979. This open-ended working group will, as its principal task, continue the consideration of matters men+ oned in Commissio decision 4 (XXXIII) entitled "Further promotion and encouragement of human rights and fundamental freedoms including the question of the programme and methods of work of the Commission" as well as those referred to the Commission by General Assembly resolution 32/130 entitled "Alternative approaches and ways and means within the United Nations system for improving the effective enjoyment of human rights and fundamental freedoms", and, secondarily, prepare for the Commission concrete drafting proposals for a draft convention on torture and other cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment.
- 4. With reference to item 18 entitled "Draft declaration on the elimination of all forms of intolerance and of discrimination based on religion or belief", it may be recalled that the Commission by its resolution 22 (XXXIV) decided to establish a working group open to all members of the Commission which would meet on a regular basis throughout the thirty-fifth session of the Commission to continue the elaboration of the draft declaration.
