Corrigendum

Paragraph 21, page 8, replace the first two sentences by the following:

"21. At first the number of these Balubas was relatively small, but with continuing persecutions and massacres in the African sections they began to accumulate in large numbers around the headquarters of the Swedish contingent. By 15 October they were estimated at approximately 35,000. The Katanga authorities had also decided, on 31 August, to transfer the prisoners held at the Kasapa prison in Elisabethville, most of whom were political opponents of Mr. Tshombe's regime."
