LETTER DATED 22 SEPTEMBER 1961 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF THE UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS ADDRESSED TO THE
PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

In connexion with the forthcoming meeting of the Security Council which is to deal with the question of the admission of new Members, the Soviet delegation deems it necessary to state the following:

As is well known, one of the world's most ancient States, the Mongolian People's Republic, has been awaiting admission to the United Nations for the past fifteen years.

In view of the assertion in the most recent statement by the Mongolian People's Republic (A/4645) that "The Mongolian people and its Government consider that all the statements made to the United Nations, since 1946, by the Government of the Mongolian People's Republic in regard to its application for membership remain in force", the Soviet delegation requests the circulation, as Security Council documents, of this letter and of all statements by the Mongolian People's Republic concerning its application for membership, i.e.:

1. The statement of 24 June 1946 (S/95);
2. The statement of 15 October 1948 (S/1035 and S/1035/Add.1);
3. The cable dated 13 September 1956 from the Chairman of the Council of Ministers of the Mongolian People's Republic addressed to the Secretary-General of the United Nations;
4. The cable dated 13 December 1956 from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Mongolian People's Republic addressed to the Secretary-General;
5. The cable from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Mongolian People's Republic addressed to the President of the Security Council and the memorandum of 9 September 1957 of the Government of the Mongolian People's Republic (S/3873 and S/3873/Add.1);

6. Statement of 7 December 1960 by the Government of the Mongolian People's Republic (A/4645).
