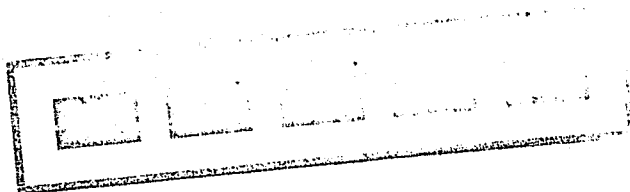

REPORT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE
SECURITY COUNCIL CONCERNING THE CREDENTIALS OF THE
REPRESENTATIVE OF COLOMBIA ON THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Pursuant to rule 15 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General wishes to report that he has received a cablegram dated 29 July 1953 from the Minister of Foreign Affairs of Colombia, stating that Dr. Francisco Urrutia, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary, has been appointed principal representative of Colombia on the Security Council.

In the opinion of the Secretary-General, this cablegram constitutes adequate credentials.
