Note of the Administrator

Summary

The present note contains information on the second and third one-year extensions of the country programmes for Burundi and Lebanon. The requests for second or third one-year extensions of country programmes, as well as two-year extensions, are submitted to the Executive Board for approval.

Elements of a decision

The Executive Board may wish to approve a second one-year extension of the country programme for Burundi from 1 January 2009 to 31 December 2009; and a third one-year extension of the country programme for Lebanon from 1 January 2009 to 31 December 2009, as presented in the annex.
