CABLEGRAM DATED 28 OCTOBER 1950 FROM THE MINISTRE FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS
OF THE CENTRAL PEOPLE'S GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF
CHINA ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY GENERAL, FOR TRANSMITTAL
TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL, CONCERNING
AN ALLEGED VIOLATION OF THE TERRITORIAL AIR OF
CHINA

PEKING, 28 OCTOBER 1950

ACCORDING TO REPORTS OF OUR EAST CHINA MILITARY AND POLITICAL COUNCIL,
AT 13.30 ON 7 OCTOBER, A UNITED STATES AIRPLANE INVADED CHINA'S AIR ABOVE
THE NORTHEASTERN PART OF CHEN SHANTOU, A HUNDRED NAUTICAL MILES NORTH EAST
OF TSINGTAO, AND STRAFED THE AREA; THEN, FLYING AT LOW LEVEL, IT
RECONNOITRED ALONG SHIHIAO (13.50), CHEN SHANTOU, WETHAIWEI (14.30) AND
FUSHAN (16.00). AT 10.00 ON 14 OCTOBER, ANOTHER UNITED STATES AIRPLANE
STRAFE FISHING BOAT NO. 10 OF THE YENTAI AQUATIC PRODUCTS COMPANY ON THE
SEA OFF SHANTUNG.

THE FACT THAT UNITED STATES MILITARY AIRPLANES REPEATEDLY INVADDED
CHINA'S TERRITORIAL AIR TO RECONNOITER AND STRAFE, AND IN ADDITION ATTACKED
CHINESE FISHING BOAT AT SEA, PROVES THAT THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT IS
EXTENDING ITS ATROCIOUS ACTION OF INVADING CHINA'S TERRITORY, TAIWAN; AND
OF VIOLATING OUR TERRITORIAL AIR ABOVE THE NORTH EASTERN PART OF CHINA, TO
AN ENCRACMENT ON THE COASTAL PART OF CHINA. THIS IS WHAT THE CHINESE
PEOPLE ABSOLUTELY CANNOT TOLERATE. IN THE NAME OF THE CENTRAL PEOPLE'S
GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA, I HEREBY LODGE A SERIOUS
PROTEST AGAINST THIS KIND OF ATROCITIES OF AGGRESSION COMMITTED BY THE
UNITED STATES MILITARY AIRPLANES, AND ONCE MORE RAISE THE ACCUSATION BEFORE
THE UNITED NATIONS AND DEMAND THAT THE UNITED NATIONS SECURITY COUNCIL
IMMEDIATELY TAKE EFFECTIVE MEASURES TO STOP SUCH AGGRESSIVE ACTION ON THE
PART OF THE UNITED STATES, AND BRING ABOUT THE WITHDRAWAL OF THE UNITED
STATES ARMED FORCES WHICH HAVE BEEN CARRYING ON AGGRESSION AGAINST CHINA'S
TERRITORY, TAIWAN, AND CHINA'S NEIGHBOURING COUNTRY, KOREA. IT IS MOST
