**Summary statement by the Secretary-General on matters of which the Security Council is seized and on the stage reached in their consideration****Addendum**

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, and in accordance with paragraph 7 of the note by the President dated 19 December 2007 (S/2007/749), the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The complete list of items of which the Security Council was seized as at 3 May 2008 is contained in document S/2008/10/Add.17 of 7 May 2008.

The present addendum lists the items on which the Security Council took action during the week ending 24 May 2008. The dates given for each item indicate when the item was first taken up by the Council at a formal meeting, and the most recent formal meeting of the Council held on that item.

**The situation in Bosnia and Herzegovina** (9 September 1992; 19 May 2008)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5894th meeting, held on 19 May 2008. The Council, under rule 37 of its provisional rules of procedure, invited the representatives of Bosnia and Herzegovina, Serbia and Slovenia, at their request, to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote. Under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure, the Council extended an invitation to Miroslav Lajčák, High Representative for the Implementation of the Peace Agreement on Bosnia and Herzegovina.

**Post-conflict peacebuilding** (26 May 2005; 20 May 2008)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5895th meeting, held on 20 May 2008. The Council, under rule 37 of its provisional rules of procedure, invited the representatives of Afghanistan, Argentina, Australia, Bangladesh, Benin, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, Chile, Egypt, El Salvador, Georgia, Germany, Ghana, Guatemala, Honduras, India, Jamaica, Liechtenstein, Mexico, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Nigeria, Norway, Pakistan, Papua New Guinea, Peru, Qatar, the Republic of Korea, Serbia, Sierra Leone, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Switzerland, Thailand and Turkey, at their request, to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote. Under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure, the Council extended invitations to Marwan



Muasher, Senior Vice-President of the World Bank; to Lakhdar Brahimi; and to Yukio Takasu, Chairperson of the Peacebuilding Commission and Permanent Representative of Japan. The President, on behalf of the Council, made a statement (S/PRST/2008/16).

**The situation in the Middle East** (18 July 1960; 22 May 2008)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5896th meeting, held on 22 May 2008. The Council, under rule 37 of its provisional rules of procedure, invited the representative of Lebanon, at his request, to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote. The President, on behalf of the Council, made a statement (S/PRST/2008/17).

**The situation in Burundi** (25 October 1993; 22 May 2008)

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 5897th meeting, held on 22 May 2008. The Council, under rule 37 of its provisional rules of procedure, invited the representative of Burundi, at his request, to participate in the consideration of the item without the right to vote. Under rule 39 of its provisional rules of procedure, the Council extended an invitation to the Chairman of the Burundi configuration of the Peacebuilding Commission and Permanent Representative of Norway.
