This proposal is a revision of ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2007/10 introduced during the fifty-seventh session of the Working Party on Lighting and Light-Signalling (GRE). The modification to the current text of the Regulation (including Supplement 13 to the Regulation) is marked in bold characters.

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## A. PROPOSAL

Paragraph 1., amend to read:

## "1. SCOPE

This Regulation applies to daytime running lamps for vehicles of category  ${\bf L}$ ,  ${\bf M}$ ,  ${\bf N}$  and T  $\underline{1}/."$ 

## B. JUSTIFICATION

This document complements the proposal tabled by the expert from Germany (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2008/58) for amendments to Regulation No. 53, proposing to allow the installation of daytime running lamps, approved according to Regulation No. 87, on  $L_3$  category vehicles.

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
