LETTER DATED 31 OCTOBER 1956 FROM THE REPRESENTATIVE OF BOLIVIA ADDRESSED
TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

In accordance with instructions received from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that Bolivia is in favour of the initiative taken by the United States of America and other Powers for consideration of the situation in Hungary by the Security Council.

The Bolivian Government's support of this initiative is in keeping with its traditional and unwavering adherence to the principles of the right of peoples to self-determination and of non-intervention in the internal affairs of States underlying international law in the Americas and contained in the United Nations Charter.
