CABLEGRAM DATED 3 NOVEMBER 1956 FROM THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS OF THE HUNGARIAN PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC, ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL
