CABLEGRAM DATED 3 NOVEMBER 1956 FROM THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COUNCIL OF  
MINISTERS OF THE HUNGARIAN PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC, ADDRESSED TO THE  
SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Chairman and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Council of Ministers of the Hungarian People's Republic in view of the statement made by Mr. Sobolev, Permanent Soviet Delegate at the session of the Security Council of the United Nations, wishes to bring the foregoing to Your Excellency's attention.

The Government of the Hungarian People's Republic herewith confirms that all telegrams, letters and messages as well as the information contained therein sent to Your Excellency now and in the future express the official standpoint of the whole Hungarian Government. I hereby inform Your Excellency that to confirm the foregoing the Hungarian Government has instructed its United Nations Representative also to bring the foregoing to Your Excellency's attention.
